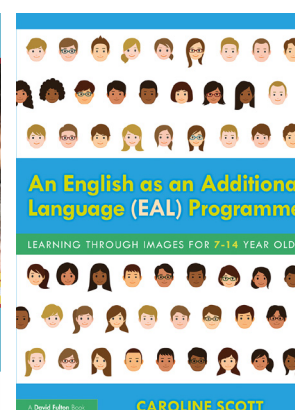
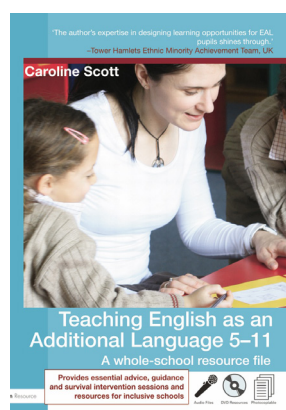

## WHO IS IT FOR?

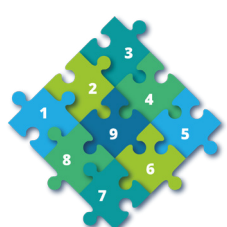
